Socially Responsible Investors

Socially Responsible Investing (SRI), also known as sustainable, is any investment strategy which seeks to consider both financial return and social good.

The evaluation criteria of Socially Responsible Investors are based on the belief that a sustainable company creates long-term value, because it is able to anticipate risks and opportunities arising from social and environmental changes. SRIs invest in companies included in the main Sustainability Indexes (Dow Jones Sustainability Indexes (DJSI), Advanced Sustainable Performance Indices (ASPI), FTSE ECPI.

The Sustainability Report is the main tool by which SRIs can evaluate how sustainable a company is.

Preventive safety systems

Information system, onboard comfort and signaling system risk, DAS (Driver Attention Support) which continuously monitors the driver's attention level, ACC (Adaptive Cruise Control), LDWS (Lane Departure Warning System) which provides an audible warning when the vehicle crosses highway lane markers without signalling, Hill Holder, Xenon Headlights, DRL (Daytime Running Lights).

Active safety systems

Steering, tires, brakes and their evolution as ABS, EBS+BAS (Electronic Braking System+Brake Assistant System) ESP (Electronic Stability Program), AEBS (Advanced Emergency Braking System), which warns the driver about an imminent collision and automatically activates the brakes.





I-mobility Challenge



This is a high-level technology demonstration day that took place at the Valkenburg airstrip (close to The Hague). Participants have had a chance to take the driver's seat and experience a diverse variety of technologies, systems, services & actual deployment examples in the field of intelligent mobility. In particular the event had been divided into four areas: Sustainable & Energy Efficient mobility, Cooperative systems, Smart mobility, Safe mobility. CNH Industrial partecipated with an Hi Way Iveco vehicle, with Iveco Connect and Safety Devices (static demonstration), with the NH AG Tractor in the "Eco Driving Experience Track" for the test drives (dynamic demonstration).





Supported Events

Sleep Stop, Take Your Time

The aim of this initiative is to inform and increase the awareness among drivers on issues related to sleep (excessive daytime sleepiness, respiratory disturbance in sleep, insomnia, restless leg syndrome) and the consequences of an improper driving behavior. With the collaboration of the Reference Center for Piedmont Region Sleep Disorders, the Italian Association of Sleep Medicine (AIMS), the Division of Neurology (Civil Hospital of Aosta) and the Division of Pulmonary Rehabilitation 'has been studied a screening questionnaire designed to identify possible sleep disorders in the drivers who voluntarily submit it to the test. The test will be completely anonymous and free. All project has been supported by Iveco who put at disposal a Stralis equipped with a medical devices and positioned at the truck park Les Halles d'Aoste (preferential stop place for heavy vehicles in transit to and from the Mont Blanc Tunnel).
